Mmmmm...Meursault

2019 Yves Boyer-Martenot Meursault Cuvée Fernand Boyer (France, Burgundy, Côte de Beaune, Meursault) **\$84**

Perhaps the best value in white Burgundy these days. Then throw in a great vintage like 2019 and you have the makings of an exception



wine. To wrap it up neatly, Burghound put his stamp of approval on the wine too.

Beat The Heat

2021 Château de Roquefort Rose Corail

(France, Provence, Côtes de Provence) **\$22**

It's hard to beat this high-altitude Provence Rose. A fun blend of Grenache, Syrah, Carignan + a wee



bit of Vermentino for punch. Biodynamic and Vegan and built for the hot weather as the perfect refresher.


Lyrical

2021 Domaine Comte Abbatucci Faustine Rosé Vieilles Vignes (France, Corsica, Ajaccio) **\$40**

Jean-Charles Abbatucci is one of those legendary winemakers that pipes in classical music to the vineyards during the growing



season. Does it affect the wine? We don't know how else to explain this Rose Masterpiece.



Summer Smooth

2021 Domaine de Majas Côtes
Catalanes Blanc (France,
Languedoc Roussillon, Roussillon,
Vin de Pays des Côtes Catalanes)
\$18.50

Fresh, elegant and fun. This is a unique blend of grapes that has

made, not surprisingly, a unique wine, but in the most friendly and inviting manner possible. Round, medium-full and very smooth. Floral notes abound along with gentle earth, tangerine pith and, can you taste sunshine? It sure seems like it with this wine.

2020 Inomessiniaki Moschofilero Mati Fortuna (Greece, Peloponnisos, Mantinia) \$16

It seems Socrates was strolling around these parts (Mantinia) everso-long ago. Even back then he was

probably drinking wine. Fast forward to present times and you can enjoy this incredibly affordable bottle of Moschofilero. We drank our first one over 3 days and it really was something. The second bottle was gone in about an hour.

Champagne, No Fizz

2019 Tarlant Coteaux Champenois Blanc (France, Champagne, Coteaux Champenois) \$115

Leave it to Tarlant to produce an epic 100% Chardonnay from Champagne with no fizz (well...a

tiny bit of fizz), that in a blind tasting could be mistaken for Grand Cru Chablis. Truly a wine for your Champagne lover that thinks they have it all.
