### One Liters Rock!

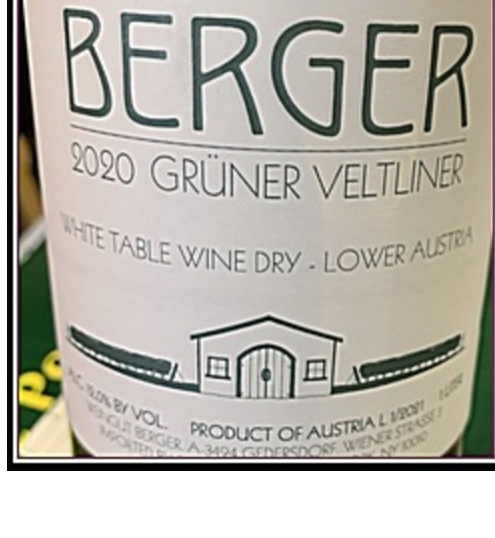
#### Weingut Berger Grüner Veltliner

(Austria, Niederösterreich, Kremstal)

**\$16.50 - 1.0 Liter Bottle**

A wonderful Summer wine that comes in a very fashionable bottle: One Liter!

A crisp and mineral-focused wine with hints of citrus, lemon peel, lychee, and a touch of spiciness. A refreshingly crisp body works great on a warm Summer day, especially when you're outdoors.



### Jacquere

#### 2020 Domaine Jean Vullien Vin de Savoie

(France, Savoie, Vin de Savoie)

**\$15.50**

This is a great introduction to the native grape from Savoie, Jacquere. This alpine wine is fresh, mineral-icious, white flower, elegant acidity, with citrus peel running down its length. Fabulous (especially for the price!)



### Grape or Region?

#### 2021 Kysela Picpoul de Pinet

(France, Languedoc Roussillon, Picpoul de Pinet) **\$14.50**

Picpoul. Is it a grape? Is it a region? YES! It's both. This is one of the best examples of the grape. A wonderful Summer refresher that pairs well with lengthy picnics. A default wine for fresh shellfish & seafood!



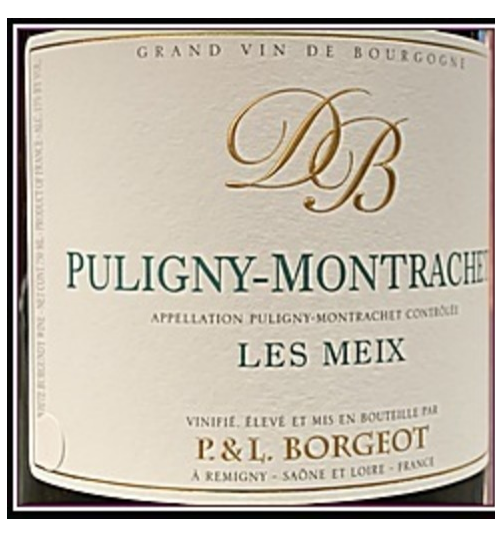
### The Neighbors

#### 2020 Domaine Borgeot Puligny-Montrachet Les Meix

(France, Burgundy, Côte de Beaune, Puligny-Montrachet) **\$82**

We find this Puligny-Montrachet to be the most mineral-rich from our line-up; savory too.

The Les Meix vineyard is located near two very prestigious vineyards, 1er Cru Les Pucelles and Grand Cru Batard Montrachet, the pedigree of the soil shows. There is a textural density that comes rolling through on the palate, spilling all the lovely pear and apple notes throughout the mid-palate. Tingly acidity punches the wine up a notch just perfectly. There's a finish that doesn't seem to want to go away. This is Chardonnay we could drink again and again.



### Classic

#### 2020 Domaine Jomain Meursault Les Tillets

(France, Burgundy, Côte de Beaune, Meursault) **\$78**

A beautifully crafted wine with all the hallmarks of the appellation. Power, finesse, length, ageability. And while you could lay this wine down for a

number of years, it's so good right now! Don't wait!

### Symphony

#### 2019 Didier Dagueneau Blanc Etc

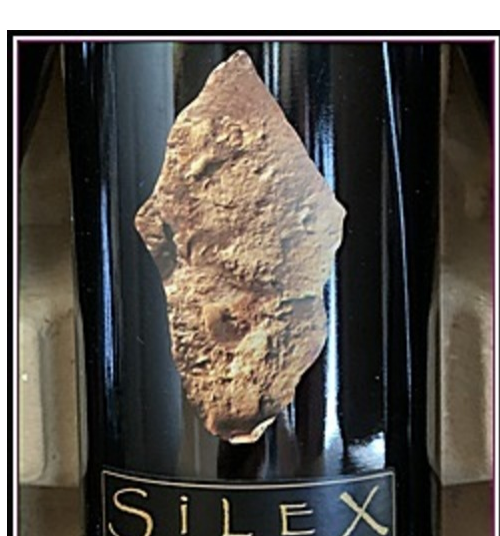
(France, Loire Valley, Vin de France) **\$105**

"Didier Dagueneau's mission was to prove that Sauvignon Blanc was one of the greatest white varieties in the world. His son, Louis-Benjamin, continues to do his late father

proud."

Ripe notes of white grapefruit, quince, acacia honey, green herbs, fresh cream, a hint of tropical fruit, and a pronounced crushed-stone minerality leap from the glass. Give it some air to reveal its lush texture, which is buttressed by spicy, tangy acidity. Even in their youth, this wine finishes with an incredible aromatic flourish. It's a full-throttle wine experience that we think merits some contemplative sipping alongside an assortment of cheeses, especially goat's milk chèvre.



### Supreme

#### 2019 Didier Dagueneau Silex

(France, Loire Valley, Vin de France) **\$162**

There are few winemakers in history as bullish or brazen, roguish or renegade, as the Loire Valley's Didier Dagueneau. High-standards, incredible risk-taking, impeccable attention to detail, zealous

allegiance to his terroir, and a willingness to take a stand against convention made this once-professional motorcycle sidecar racer the stuff of legends.

We kept our tasting notes for this wine to a minimum: Profound.

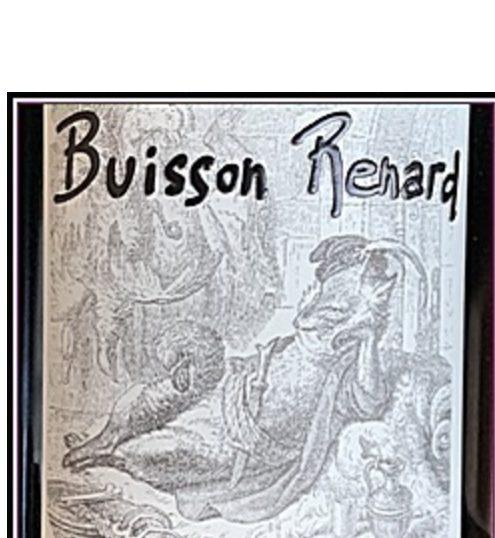
### Time Will Tell
