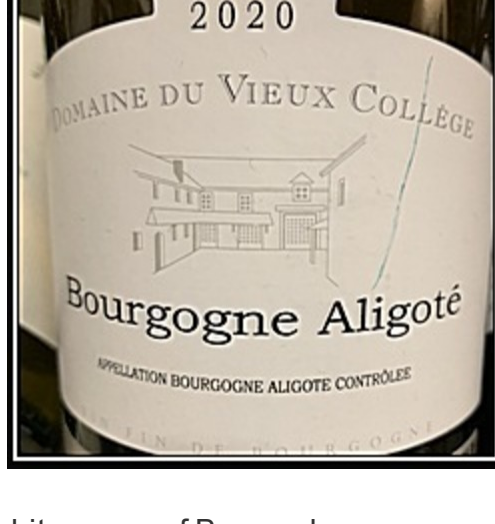

2020 Domaine du Vieux Collège Bourgogne-Aligoté

(France, Burgundy, Bourgogne-Aligoté)
\$22.50

This organic estate is dynamite; quality is top notch and pricing is super-fair. This 100% Aligote shines with citrus, apple, and floral notes. There's balance and poise here along with a very lengthy finish. Try a bottle and discover the other white grape of Burgundy.

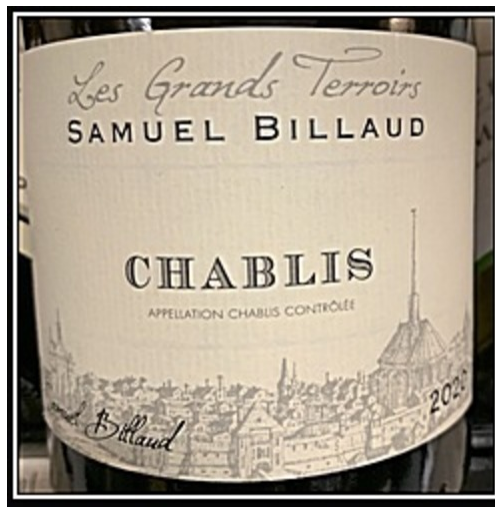


Dynamic

2020 Samuel Billaud Chablis

(France, Burgundy, Chablis) \$35

From the hardest working man in Chablis comes Samuel's latest release. Review is from Jancis Robinson: "Beautifully crisp nose, fresh and clean with a stony mineral streak. Crunchy red-apple skin, poised electric acidity and good concentration of apple and citrus fruit. Just delightfully refreshing and inviting."

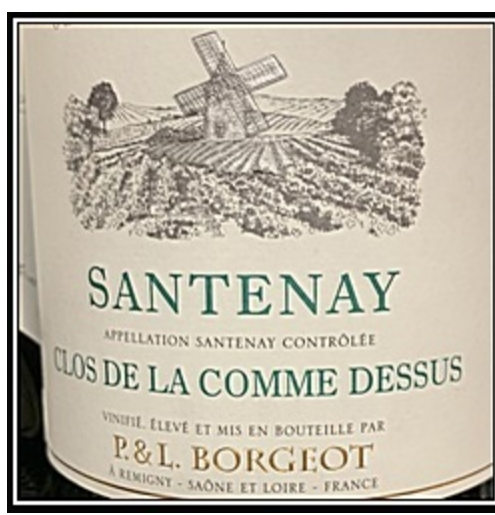


Sublime

2019 Domaine Borgeot Santenay Clos de la Comme-Dessus Blanc

(France, Burgundy, Côte de Beaune, Santenay) \$46

Our tasting notes ran the gamut from 'fresh, inviting, terrific juice' to 'fresh peach, apple, wonderfully balanced, juicy citrus acidity, and finally 'dam right silly-good'. We've carried this Domaine's wines for five vintages now and every wine seems to be dam-near perfect.

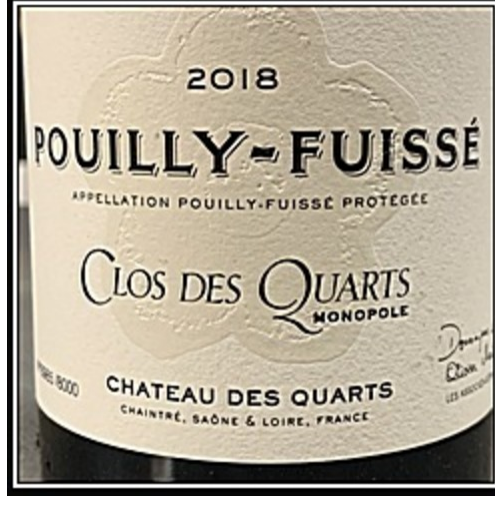

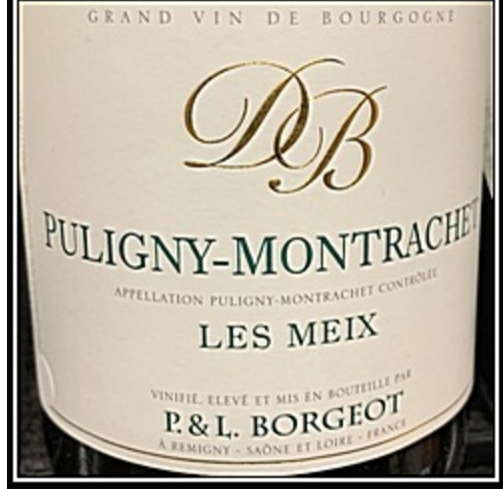
2018 Château des Quarts Pouilly-Fuissé Clos de Quarts

(France, Burgundy, Mâconnais, Pouilly-Fuissé) \$72

MAGIC! But first: Chateau des Quarts is co-owned and operated by Olivier Merlin and Dominique Lafon, two major pioneers of Burgundy's southerly Mâconnais region.



Flavors of pithy citrus, stone fruit, lime flower, and earth spice dominate this bright and harmonious Chardonnay. We believe that some of Burgundy's best-kept secrets are found in Pouilly-Fuissé -- this bottle is no exception!



Top-Drawer

2020 Domaine Borgeot Puligny-Montrachet Les Meix

(France, Burgundy, Côte de Beaune, Puligny-Montrachet) \$82

"White Gold!" was our first thought. Outstanding Puligny that we ordered on the spot at the trade tasting. This is pure and bright with subtle hints of orchard fruit and snazzy acidity. A classic

example of Puligny.



Stupefaction

2019 Domaine de Montille Bourgogne

(France, Burgundy, Bourgogne) \$46.50

We do not always expect comments like 'magical' and 'seriously?' when tasting wines from the general appellation of Bourgogne but wow, we were pleasantly surprised at the depth, confidence, and quality of this wine. It's a restrained tiger with all the merits a premier cru wine

might have. Bravo Domaine de Montille.



Revivify

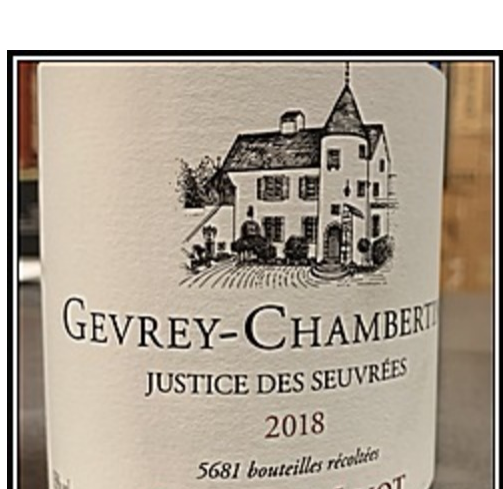
2020 Anne Sophie Dubois Fleurie Les Cocottes

(France, Burgundy, Beaujolais, Fleurie) \$34

We've featured wines from this young, brilliant winemaker before. Today we are introducing her latest release of 'Les Cocottes', her most Bojo Beaujolais.

100% whole cluster produces a wine that is tart, tasty, and seriously delicious. Very coy tannins make this dangerously easy to drink. Bright, with alluring aromas of summer cherries, pomegranate, and whiffs of dark berries. Fleurie's telltale minerality is at the core with a hint of pepper spice on the finish.

This wine radiates bliss.



Outstanding!

2018 Domaine Perrot-Minot Gevrey-Chambertin

(France, Burgundy, Côte de Nuits, Gevrey-Chambertin) \$150

When the Burghound hands out an 'Outstanding' to a wine we take notice. "...ripe dark berry fruit and savage scents. There is both excellent freshness and verve to the solidly powerful, indeed

even robust, medium weight flavors that retain good focus on the detailed and lingering finish." --Burghound

What he didn't mention is the wine needed about 4-5 hours in the decanter. THEN it really became something else. Enjoy the wine with duck confit, lamb loin, beef bourguignon.
