The Amazing Mr. Anthony Thevenet



Anthony Thevenet's interpretation of Beaujolais is a unique combination of wines from decades past and today's trend of voluptuously fruity, early-drinking renditions with a serious edge. After cutting his teeth in the cellar of Georges Descombes, one of the local veterans of natural winemaking, followed by five years as the right hand man of Jean Foillard, **one of the true luminaries** of Beaujolais, he went out on his own.

If you tasted his wines at the beginning with his fantastic 2013 and 2014 vintages, the writing was already on the wall: he is **destined to carve out a place among the best in Beaujolais during our lifetime.**

Renegade was lucky enough to receive all five of his new releases ranging from his crafty Beaujolais-Villages to his supreme achievement: the 2017 Morgon Cuvée Centenaire created from vines **planted around the same time as the American Civil War.**

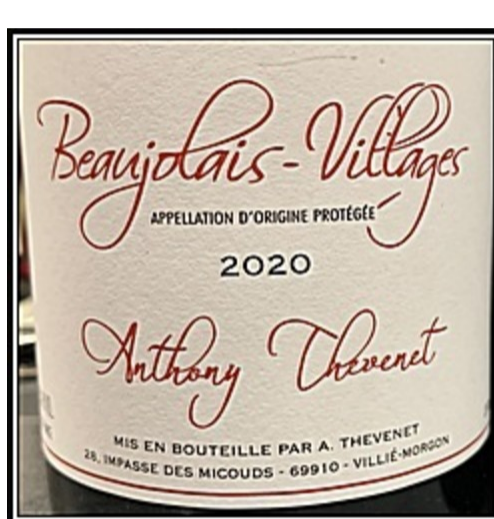

2020 Anthony Thevenet Beaujolais-Villages

(Beaujolais, Beaujolais-Villages) \$30

What an attractive wine! A rich bouquet of red cherries, ripe strawberries, with hints of cocoa. The wine is impeccably balanced with a tingly backbone of acid and a beautiful saline finish that intertwines with the gorgeous fruit finish. Virtuous.

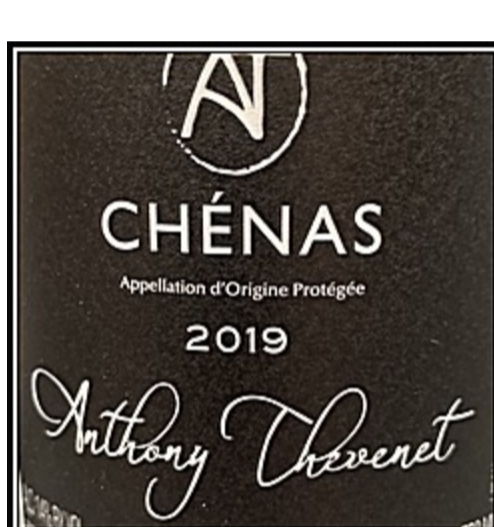


Fascinating

2019 Anthony Thevenet Chénas

(Beaujolais, Chénas) \$35

This is 100% whole cluster goodness from the smallest planted Beaujolais Cru: Chénas. An angular wine with a strong mineral presence. Light yet with plenty of delicious texture. There's red but also an amiable amount of dark fruit too. We're not a fan of using 'wet stone' as a descriptor but you know what? That's just what it might be: a core of wet stone mingling with the minerality and an unpretentious poise of graphite. Perhaps. Regardless this is a quickly, ever-changing wine in the glass. A fascinating study in Gamay.

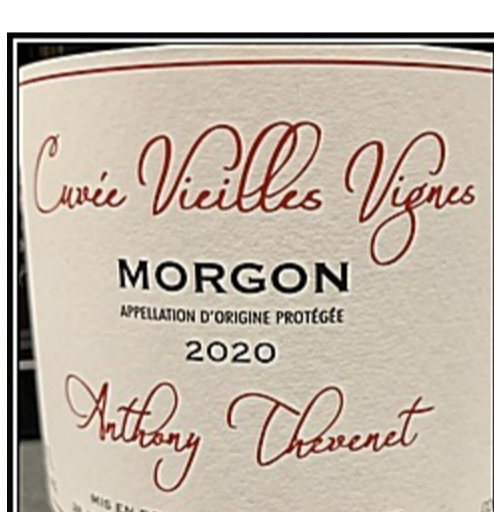


Majestic

2020 Anthony Thevenet Morgon Cuvée Vieilles Vignes

(Beaujolais, Morgon) \$42

Extremely Elegant, Deep, Refined, Regal even. Aromatically off the charts with splendiferous red fruit. There's a light, salty edge, delicate, refined minerality, and a lean but growing finish as the wine opens up.

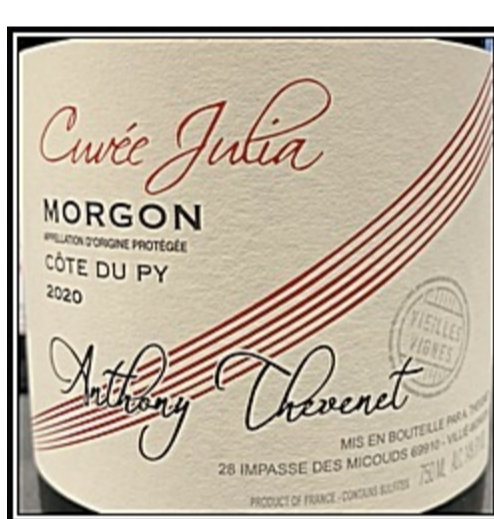


Julia, ah, Julia

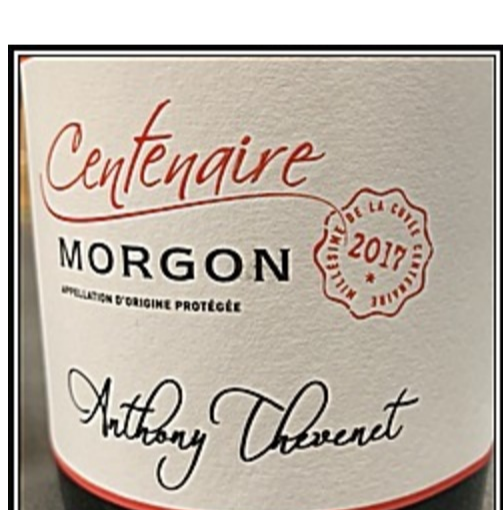
2020 Anthony Thevenet Morgon Côte du Py Cuvée Julia Vieilles Vignes

(Beaujolais, Morgon) \$44

These single-vineyard vines (planted in 1935) are located on the lower slopes of the south side of Morgon's famous hill, the Côte de Py, growing in a mix of granite sands and metamorphic stones that were once basalt before becoming a hard (as hell!) schist.



First impressions: aromas of violets with boysenberry, spice, cocoa, forest floor that are reinforced on the palate. Black cherry, blackberry, and a subtle, sly notion of minerals run throughout its length. The finish is elegant, long, and broad, and at the very back of the palate, after about 30 seconds something akin to sichuan pepper comes alive; that tingle glow –in this case subtle- that last for over a minute.

2017 Anthony Thevenet Morgon Cuvée Centenaire

(Beaujolais, Morgon) \$60

And finally to Anthony's chef-d'oeuvre, or masterpiece. This is the wine with vines planted around the same time as the American Civil War. Quickly doing the math that's approximately 160 years old! Let that settle in.

A profound wine; extremely elegant, bright, complex, red fruits and flowers... multilayered. Once again there's a presence of salinity and lovely minerality, a spice towards the finish and a floral-tinged persistence. This is an energetic, emotional wine. In a word: brilliant!

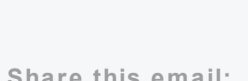
