There are quite a few new wines that have arrived this week, none more exciting than a stack of white and red Burgundies.

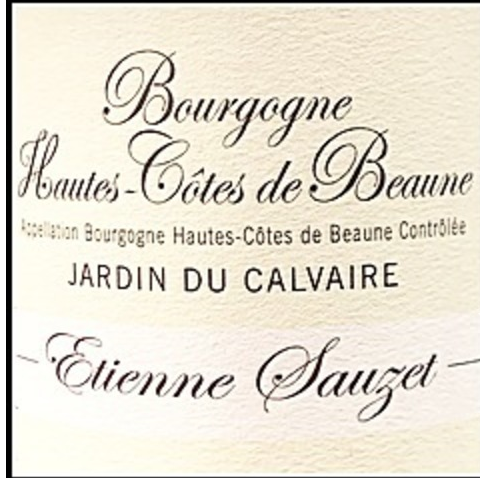

2020 Etienne Sauzet Bourgogne Hautes-Côtes de Beaune Jardin du Calvaire (France, Burgundy, Bourgogne Hautes-Côtes de Beaune) **\$60**

From the Burgundy mind of Allen Meadows: "there is a lovely sense of verve and freshness to the appealingly textured flavors that exude a subtle minerality on the chiseled and sneaky long finale. This is excellent...and well-worth considering."

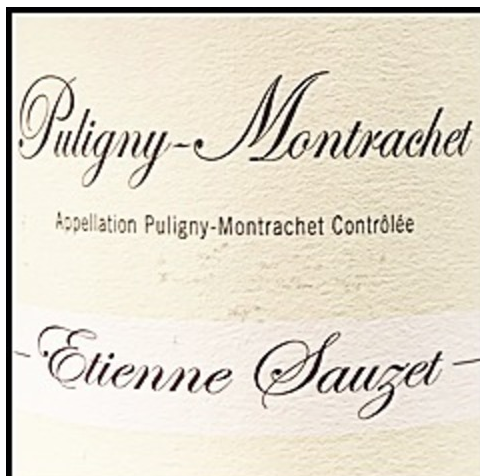

2020 Etienne Sauzet Puligny-Montrachet (France, Burgundy, Côte de Beaune, Puligny-Montrachet) **\$118**

Once again from the mind of Allen Meadows: "Smoky and equally cool aromas are laced with more evident floral nuances to the pear, apple and anise wisps that are trimmed in a discreet touch of wood influence. The rich, generously proportioned and concentrated medium weight flavors possess good focus and punch on the lingering finale."

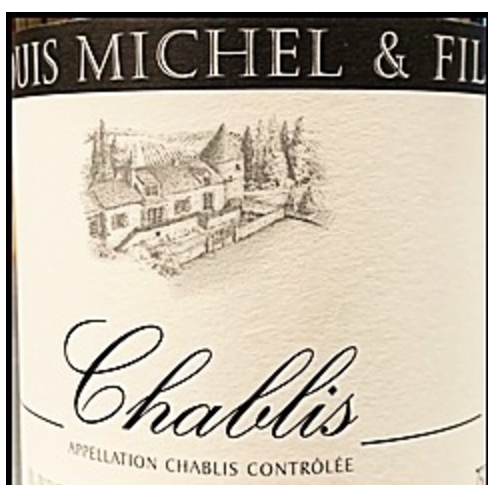


And from us: "We never grow tired of the wines from Etienne Sauzet. Did someone say lobster?"

Sagacious

2019 Domaine Henri Clerc & Fils Puligny-Montrachet (France, Burgundy, Côte de Beaune, Puligny-Montrachet) **\$98**

This wine is pure Puligny: focused, racy and pure, with notes of crisp tropical and pear fruit and an enjoyably long finish. It has a focused texture, well balanced with a lively acidity the French would call "nervosité."



Sublime

2020 Domaine Louis Michel Chablis (France, Burgundy, Chablis) **\$36**

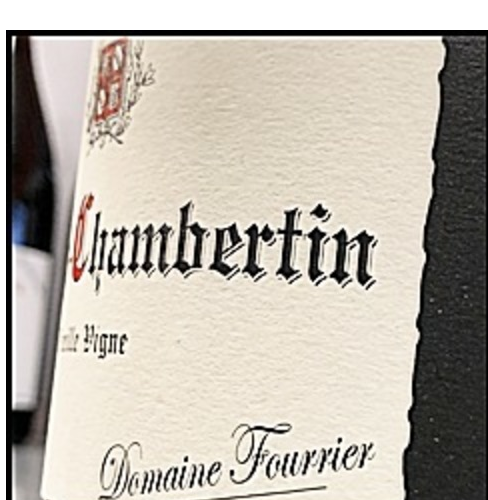
It's hard not to like the purity of a Louis Michel Chablis and this 2020 is just that. Bright, wonderful, long and lean, green apples, hint of spice, minerals, in a word (two): classic Chablis.



Wine for its Own Sake

2019 Jérôme Chezeaux Nuits St. Georges Les Charbonnières Vieilles Vignes (France, Burgundy, Côte de Nuits, Nuits St. Georges) **\$80**

This was a great find: red currant and cranberry commingling with orange blossom and spice. good intensity, supple tannins, from 80+ year-old vines. The wine has a real sense of place; you taste and you know: this is Nuits-Saint-Georges. As you approach the bottles last drops, a savory, forest floor, umami facet emerges. Stunning.



Stupefy

2020 Domaine Fourrier Gevrey-Chambertin (France, Burgundy, Côte de Nuits, Gevrey-Chambertin) **\$150**

What ends up in the glass is a pure expression of terroir with as little interference as possible by the winemaker. Domaine Fourrier's Gevrey possess superb balance, enchanting elegance, finesse and complexity. This is the one!
