Island Wine

2021 Domaine Paterianakis

Melissinos White

(Greece, Crete) \$24

This dry white blend will seduce you with its honied flavors balanced by its bracing acidity. Domaine Paterianakis is situated 2,000 feet above sea level in the Peza appellation of the Mediterranean island of Crete. The domaine is organically certified by DIO, the official body for controlling organic certification in Greece.

This wine is a blend of the native Crete grape Thrapstathiri & Sauvignon Blanc.

2021 Tetramythos Roditis Natur e

(Greece, Peloponnisos, Achaia) \$20

There is a certain beauty in the ineluctable fact that this object lesson in "natural" wine-making (absolutely nothing added to the wine) should derive from Europe's

oldest wine culture. The sheer dimension and clarity of flavour, allied to a luxurious texture, yet all packed into an orderly frame, are breathtakingly good. There is nothing even remotely offbeat about this classy and delicious wine.



Agiorgitiko?

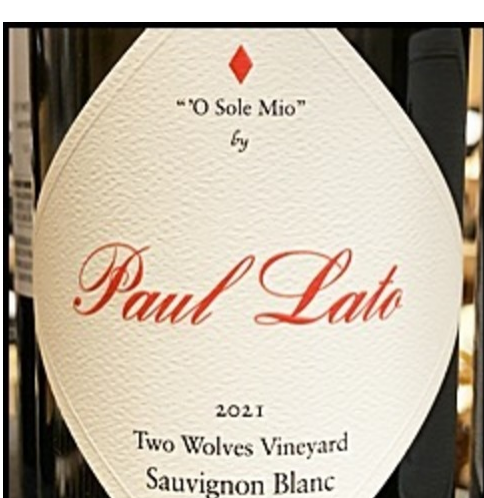
2021 Tetramythos Agiorgitiko

(Santa Ynez Valley) \$45

"I love Paul's Sauvignon Blanc, and his 2021 O Sole Mio Sauvignon Blanc Two Wolves Vineyard is a winner, offering a clean, crisp bouquet of white grapefruit, crushed citrus, white flowers, and honeyed minerality. Beautifully balanced, medium-bodied, and textured, with bright, vibrant acidity, it's a brilliant effort that will be about as versatile as they come on the dinner table." J.D.

2017 Produttori del Barbaresco

Barbaresco Riserva Montestefano

(Italy, Piedmont, Langhe, Barbaresco) \$85

Potent and savory with a brooding soul. This one needs time (decanter or cellar).

Here's Jancis' take on the wine: "Lustrous ruby with orange tinges. A little dusty at first and a little brooding with deep ripe cherry fruit and hints of dried cherry and damson. Very slow to open up. Succulent and focused cherry fruit palate filled out with bags of fine, gravelly tannins. Majestic structure and plenty of juice on the finish." 17++

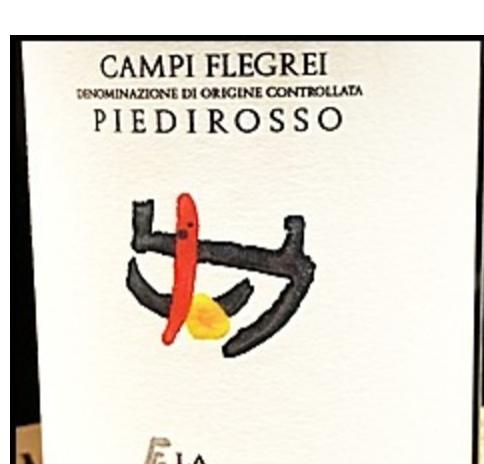


Beautiful Mistake

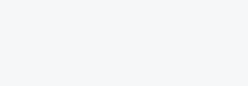
